Good day to All,

Our National Emergency Management Organisation (NEMO) has been working on an assessment of the damage from last week's natural disaster, along with assistance from the Caribbean Disaster Emergency Management Agency (CDEMA)) and the Pan-American Health Organisation (PAHO). As at today's date more than 100 homes have been completely destroyed or severely damaged, and approximately another 200 homes have been declared by the Chief Engineer as structurally unsound. At least 500 people are currently housed in temporary shelters.

The Milton Cato Memorial Hospital and some other health facilities have been flooded, causing severe damage of medical equipment and supplies. A safe and clean water supply remains a critical issue, as 50% of the country is without water—some from since Christmas eve.

The last situation report which was provided through the joint efforts of our NEMO, CDEMA, PAHO and the World Health Oraganisation is attached for your consideration.
